The festival is open to all media, fine arts, and crafts.

Three types of spaces are available:

- Outdoor (Uncovered) Craft only - (10' x 10').....\$40.00
- Indoor (Pavilion) - (10' x 10').....\$45.00
- Indoor (Air Conditioned) Pavilion (10' x 10').....\$150.00
- Outdoor Food -\$150.00

Check-in/set-up time is Friday between 8 AM and 12 PM. No one will be available to show you your space after these hours

The Festival Committee retains the privilege of changing locations of booths for unavoidable reasons.

All exhibitors are responsible for his/her own displays, stands, tables, chairs, etc. *Tables and chairs will be provided for air-conditioned indoor booths.* for an outdoor exhibit, each vendor is responsible for providing a tent. No tables or chairs will be available for rent. Exhibitors must make their own provisions for shade or rain when requesting outdoor space.

Booths shall be open the following times:

Friday 5-9 PM; Saturday 10 AM-9 PM; Sunday 11 AM-6 PM

Each booth must remain open during these times. Early closing or break-down of booth will result in penalties prohibiting vendor returning to festival for 2 years.

Each exhibitor acknowledges his/her agreement to these rules and regulations by payment of fee and signature on contract.

Only the juried crafter is to occupy the space. Sharing or subletting will result in forfeiture of booth.

The festival reserves the right to reject any inappropriate work or display and to ask any exhibitor to leave who fails to meet the overall standards of the festival.

Artist must clear usage of the Beauregard Watermelon Festival Logo with Festival Officials prior to appearing on site.

The festival will provide limited 24-hour security, but cannot assume liability for damage, loss, or theft of an individual's product.

Motel reservations/RV/Camper space should be made as soon as possible.

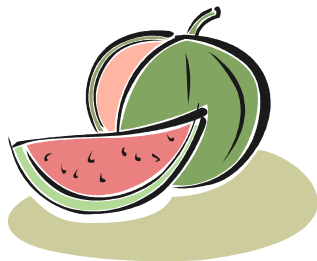
